Dear Parents/Carers,

I am pleased to confirm that owing to the Government's announcement earlier this week that school will be returning to "normal" in September. Control measures which have been so effective such as ensuring good hygiene (e.g. hand washing and using sanitiser), strict cleaning regimes, keeping occupied spaces ventilated and following Public Health advice will remain in place. A new risk assessment will be on our school website for the start of term. Pupils, staff and other adults should not come into school if they have symptoms or a positive test result. There may still be instances where Public Health might advise us to temporarily reintroduce some additional control measures.

From 2nd September:

- School will open for Key Stages 1 & 2 at 8.50 am and end at 1515. Classes will line up on the playground as normal. White Horse class will be open at 9am and end at 1500.
- School bubbles will no longer be needed and children will be able to learn and play together again.
- Wayland class will move back to their normal classroom.
- Face coverings for adults, both inside and outside school will be a personal choice.
- Breakfast club will be able to take up to 24 children per session and will be based in the hall.
- Whole school assemblies will take place in the hall.
- Children will be able to eat lunch together in the hall.
- From 16th August 2021, children under the age of 18yrs old will no longer be required to self isolate if they are contacted by NHS Test and Trace as a close contact of a positive COVID 19 case.
- Classes will not need to isolate if there is a child or adult with a confirmed positive Coronavirus case (however parents and carers will be informed if this does occur).
- The one way system will not need to be strictly followed, but please be courteous to other adults when dropping and collecting your child/ren.
